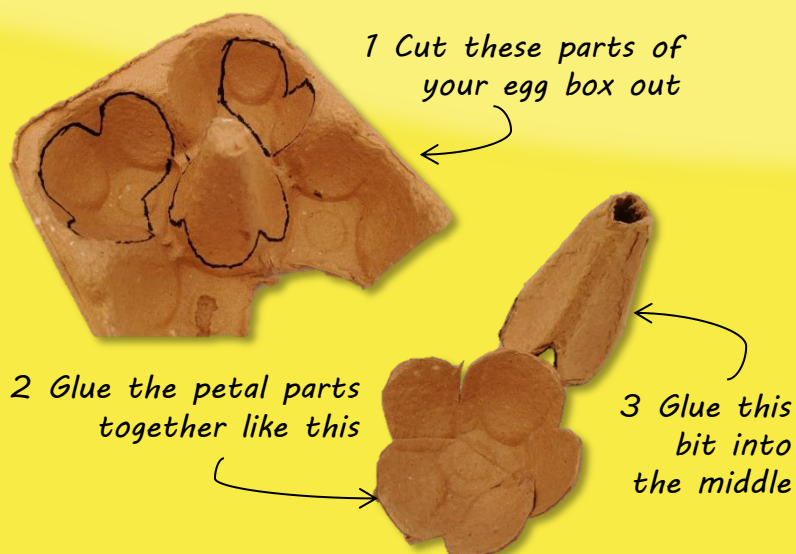

Make 3D daffodils

If you have an empty egg carton you can create 3D flowers. Simply cut out the shapes, glue together and paint or colour them. Using a yellow egg carton makes the job even easier! A straw or a tube of rolled paper can be used as a stalk. We've used some cut up ribbon in the centre of our flowers.



1 Cut these parts of your egg box out

2 Glue the petal parts together like this

3 Glue this bit into the middle
